Rules & Regulations

Because of overloading possibilities in Prora to compare with requests from the federations, FMJD decided to change location. New localisation is in Poland. It is the region of Poland localisation which change nothing according transport for the people. Still Berlin is the closest airport. Key points changed in official rules and regulation has been marked.

1. The World Championship Youth 2023 is organized by the FMJD in cooperation with the Polish Draughts Federation.

Schedule

2. Schedule of the event will be published shortly before. The main frameworks are as follow:

Participants

- 4. There will be 10 separate official World Championship Tournaments:
 - 4.1. Juniors Boys Open (B19) boys born 1st of January 2004 or later.
 - 4.2. Juniors Girls (G19) girls born 1st of January 2004 or later.
 - 4.3. Cadets Boys Open (B16) boys born 1st of January 2007 or later.
 - 4.4. Cadets Girls (G16) girls born 1st of January 2007 or later.
 - 4.5. Mini Cadets Boys Open (B13) boys born 1st of January 2010 or later.
 - 4.6. Mini Cadets Girls (G13) players born 1st of January 2010 or later.
 - 4.7. Hopes Boys Open (B10) boys born 1st of January 2013 or later.
 - 4.8. Hopes Girls (G10) girls born 1st of January 2013 or later.
 - 4.9. Young Stars Boys Open (BYS) boys born 1st of January 2015 or later.
 - 4.10. Young Stars Girls (GYS) girls born 1st of January 2015 or later.
- 5. Girls are allowed to play in open groups.
- 6. Maximal number of players from one country in the same group 3
- Sponsor places will be auctioned (10 places in total). Minimum amount is 200 €. Federation interesting in must send a document before September 5th. If more federations will be interested in a biding procedure will be organised.

Disciplines

- 8. Classical draughts with games rate:
 - 8.1. Groups B19, G19, B16, G16 90' for first 45 moves and after + 30' + 30"/move (Fischer)
 - 8.2. Groups B13, G13, B10, G10 80' + 60"/move (Fischer)
 - 8.3. Groups BYS, GYS 90' + 30"/move (Fischer)
 - 9. Rapid with games rate: 15' + 5"/move (Fischer)
 - 10. <u>Blitz</u> with games rate: 5' + 3"/move (Fischer)

Technical details

- 11. Number of rounds to be confirmed by the main referee in the technical meeting.
- 12. The official software Draughts Arbiter will be used.

National team classification

- 13. The national team classification is based on individual results of players representing their national federation.
 - 13.1. The best 3 players from one country in the final classification obtain points in each age group, the calculation is done by percentage score + bonus points for top 10 places (bonus points exactly like in World Cup: 1st 100, 2nd 70, ..., 10th 20). Example 6 points out of 9 rounds and 21st place gives 33 points for the country. 1st place with 15 points gives 183 points (100 + 83).
 - 13.2. There will be separate classifications in classic, blitz and rapid championships, in each classification results of boys and girls groups will be counted together

Competition fee

- 14. Competition fee (according to FMJD Internal Regulations): Classic 25 €, Rapid 10 €, Blitz 10 €
- 15. Payments only to FMJD bank account (see p. 26 & 27).
- 16. September 25th it is a deadline to pay competition fee.

Prizes

- 17. Categories G13, B13, G16, B16, G19, B19 will received financial rewards.
- 18. Money prizes will be transferred to account provided by national federations after the tournament.

Accommodation

- 19. Hotel charges (with breakfast/dinner/supper):
 - 19.1.1. Total amount per person per day is equal 52 €.
 - 19.1.2. This contains 2-person or 3-person. Family rooms (on requests) for 4-persons on request.
 - 19.1.3. Children below 3 years are free.
 - 19.2. Free hospitality (paid by the organisers)
 - 19.2.1. for each 3rd player from the same federation in the group. Means if 1 or 2 players in the group all must pay; if 3 players in the group, one place is for free.
 - 19.2.2. If federation did not get free places on the condition above then one player from whole delegation will be for free.
 - 19.2.3. Means at least one competitor from each federation will receive a free hotel.
 - 20. Payments of the accommodation only to FMJD bank account (see p. 26 & 27).

 September 25th it is a deadline to pay.
 - 21. Accommodation is possible only in the hotel provided by organizer. Entry to the playing venue is not possible for those who lives in another places.

- 22. Applications must be sent from National Federation
 - (<u>1 federation=1 document</u>) using attached file (2311_WCY_Application). One person who will be present during the event, must be nominated in this application as a Chief of delegation. If visa invitation is needed, please include proper data into file 2311_WCY_Application and provide scans of passport.
